Some waters have specific rules which will be printed on your ticket. However, there are some General Rules that apply to All Waters:

Age Specific Rules

Persons under the age of 12 years are not allowed to fish any water unless accompanied by an adult, and then they must fish within 10 metres of the adult. Persons aged 12 and over can fish all other still waters (including canals) unaccompanied, during daylight hours only. Persons under 14 years may only fish with one rod. Persons under 16 years are not allowed to fish rivers, or night fish, unless accompanied by an Adult. Persons aged between 16 and 18 years may fish at night unaccompanied on the Macclesfield and Montgomery Canals only when the Society have received written consent from a parent or guardian. Please contact the Membership Secretary for further details.

Other Rules

- *All coarse fish over 5lb must be returned immediately to the water and not retained in keepnets.*
- *The use of carp sacks is not allowed.*
- *The use of weigh slings to retain carp for any period of time is not allowed.*
- *Keepnets may not be used between 15th March to 15th June, inclusive.*
- *Carp, Barbel and Pike anglers must use an adequate unhooking mat. All anglers when fishing from landing stages must use unhooking mats.*
- *Pike fishing is restricted to the use of lures only between the 15th March and 30th September, inclusive. Pike anglers must not introduce live baitfish. Any coarse fish live bait must have been caught in the water being fished, (maximum size 6oz). The number of baits used must not exceed 6 in any one day. Wire traces must be used at all times.*
