LLYN BRENIG FISHING REPORT - Week Ending August 1st 2025.

Fishing this week has been very unpredictable with fish being caught on both dry flies and lures. This was highlighted on Thursday when one boat caught seventeen fish using dry flies and another boat catching 19 fish using a DI7 and lures. Fish have been caught deep using cat's whisker boobies whilst fish have been taking on the top using Daddy Long Legs, Bibio Hoppers and black hopper poppers. The bank anglers have found the fish close to the bank in the warmer waters.

The weather, like the fishing has also been quite erratic with some very cloudy and quite chilly days interspersed with sunny and bright periods. You would think that the conditions would be very conducive to fishing but the rod average of three fish per angler does belie this idea.

A Llyn Brenig Fishing Competition will be taking place on Sunday September 28th. If you are interested in taking part, then please either book a place online or pop into the fishing shop and book there The Llyn Brenig Competition is fly fishing only. Entry is £60 per angler. £30 for Llyn Brenig Season ticket holders. The Prizes are £500 cash for first place, a full season ticket for second place and a half season ticket for third place. There is no cash alternative for the season tickets.

A hot bap and hot drink are included and served after the weigh in.

The fishing rules are the standard Llyn Brenig fly fishing rules found within the current terms and conditions leaflet.

To summarise this:

- Boat only competition.
- 2 anglers to a boat, there will be a draw to allocate anglers to their boats.
- Fly only
- 3 fish weigh in. This can be Rainbows or Browns
- Catch and release thereafter with 2lb per fish

This weekend we are hosting the Llanilar Classic with over 35 boats taking part. The practice days have been quite testing with anglers working out their methodology and tactics. Sunday might be a bit more challenging weather wise, but we are looking forward to a good day of fishing. It is good to welcome anglers from all over the Uk and the Irish Republic and it is great to see old friendships renewed.

Boat anglers' hot spots have been the Quarry, Tower Bay, along the Dam Wall, Hafod Lom and Sailing Club Bay.

Bank anglers hot spots have been Ring of Stones, Tower Bay, Sailing Club Bay and Visitors Centre.

The top flies this week are cats whiskers, daddy long legs, bibio hopper and various Blobs and Boobies.

The main gates will be shutting at 6.00pm this week and all boats need to be back on the jetty by 5.15pm.
